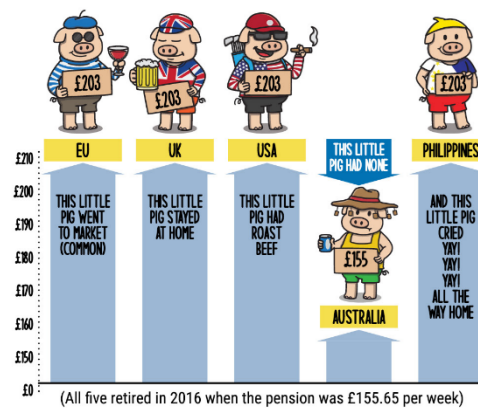

BRITISH PENSIONS IN AUSTRALIA (BPiA)



What is BPiA?

BPiA is a registered charity dedicated to caring for British State Pension recipients in Australia.

We were incorporated under the Associations Incorporation Act 2009 (NSW) in 2003.

We are staffed entirely by unpaid volunteers.

BPiA has adopted a membership funding model. This provides us with more reliable income to fund our activities. We ask people we help to join BPiA and agree to pay a modest annual membership fee. There is no obligation to join. We also ask members to add a donation to their membership fee.

How we help people who receive or with the passage of time will receive British State Pension

We help people navigate the convoluted rules of the British state pension scheme. We lobby on their behalf to end the UK government's frozen pensions policy.

Amongst other things, our assistance includes guidance on how to:

- Get a state pension forecast.
- Understand the merits of voluntary contributions.
- Claim British state pension.

BPiA has a library of Fact Sheets that provide information in plain English on all aspects of British state pension.

BPiA DOES NOT CHARGE TO HELP PEOPLE DISCOVER THEIR ENTITLEMENTS.

Our Campaign

BPiA campaigns to end the UK's policy of frozen pensions.

We work together with Canadian Alliance of British Pensioners to bring maximum pressure on the UK government. Both organisations are members of the International Consortium of British Pensioners (ICBP).

ICBP employs the UK's leading lobbying company to ensure our message is heard by the UK Government, MPs and by the British public through newspaper articles, radio and television programmes.

We support the All-Party Parliamentary Group (APPG) on Frozen Pensions. The APPG is a group of members of the House of Commons and members of the House of Lords of all parties who believe the UK government

frozen pensions policy is wrong and want to see it change.
